

Milwood Neighborhood Association Meeting Notes

March 19, 2024

- Location: IBEW Meeting Hall
- In Attendance: 55 (*at start of meeting*)
 - Translator available but no Spanish Speakers were in attendance
- Introductions of Meeting Organizers
 - Made comments about the purpose of the organization
 - Will not be a Neighborhood Watch or HOA
- Current State of Milwood Neighborhood Organization
 - Has 501c3 Status
 - No governing Bylaws have been found and may not have ever been created
- Concerns/Comments raised by attendees
 - Question: How was this meeting advertised?
 - Answer: There was a media blast on the radio, notifications on social media, a new website was created, flyers and yard signs around the neighborhood
 - Question: How was the board slate determined?
 - Answer: Out-reach out to community members and asked who was interested in joining the board and got some initial volunteers
 - Question: Will there be an opportunity for a real election?
 - Answer: Another election will come but needed to put together a board quickly to start creating the bylaws
 - Question: Is this in interim board since there wasn't as big of an opportunity to nominate/volunteer board members?
 - Answer: This will be an acting board to establish bylaws to create a fully functional nonprofit but the bylaws will determine how a new election will occur
 - Additional Comments: Many in favor of term lengths included in bylaws
 - Comment: We are trying to create something now that can be used to have a more official election at an annual meeting once the bylaws are created
